



Dementia Certification Renewal

These certifications represent your commitment to providing optimal care to those living with dementia and their loved ones.

Certified Memory Care Professional Certification (CMCP)

- > Professionals must have completed fifteen (15) total CEU's before the recertification date
- > Ten (10) CEU's of the required fifteen (15) must come from a IEMC topical training course.
- > Additional CEU's must focus on dementia or geriatric care
- > CMCP is renewable every two (2) years.

Qualified Memory Care Professional Certification (QMCP)

- > Professionals must have completed twenty (20) total CEU's before the recertification date
- > Ten (10) CEU's of the required twenty (20) must come from a IEMC topical training course.
- > Additional CEU's must focus on dementia, geriatric care, or leadership
- > QMCP is renewable every two (2) years.

To Renew

1. Professionals must provide proof of attendance and the designated number of contact hours for each training class. *IEMC continuing education log can be found on our webpage at alzni.org*
